

## WEATHER FORECAST: CAPÍTULO 7-ESPAÑOL 1

You are a weather forecaster for a local Spanish-speaking TV station. Using your vocabulary from chapter 7 and/or the dictionary, create a weather forecast for yesterday (preterite), today (present), and tomorrow (future). You'll want to create a weather poster similar to those used by forecasters on TV. Because you are creating your own weather forecast, be sure to make the weather different for each of the three days. Things you might want to include are, temperature, precipitation, things you can do because of or in spite of the weather, clothing you will need, etc. Once you have designed your forecast, you will perform it in front of the class. Although you should be rehearsed, you may not read it nor should it sound memorized. Your presentation should be at least 2 minutes, but no longer than 5 minutes.

Areas that you should consider when doing this assignment are overall presentation including props and creativity, vocabulary usage, and structure usage. Doing just what is asked of you will earn you a C. **In order to excel on this assignment, you must go far beyond the minimum requirements identified here. An A is very difficult to earn.** Obviously, all information must be presented in Spanish. For this assignment, you will earn 2 grades each in **STRUCTURES, VOCABULARY, and SPEAKING.**

After you are finished with the project, please answer the **Self-Assessment/Reflection** questions on a separate piece of paper. There will be a separate grade for this part of the assignment that will go under **REFLECTIONS.**
